

## *Ways to Practice Your Spelling Words*

*\*I may choose one or two ways for you each week. Check before you choose your own.*

### *Will count for one day of spelling homework*

1. Put the words in alphabetical (ABC) order.
2. Divide the words into syllables.
3. Write the words and circle the vowels.
4. Write the words and circle the consonants.
5. Write the words and cross out the silent letters.
6. Write the words in all different colors.
7. Write your words around a shape. Make a wagon or a smiley face.
8. Write sentences using the words.
9. Write a synonym (word that means the same) for each word.
10. Write an antonym (word that means the opposite) for each word.
11. Add prefixes or suffixes the words.
12. Make a word search with the words.
13. Write words three times. (one time is not a choice!)

13. Write the definition for each word.
14. Put the words in groups according to their part of speech.
15. Write tongue twisters with the words.
16. Make a crossword puzzle with the words.
17. Write a story or paragraph using the words.
18. Find the words in a newspaper or magazine.
19. Make "sailboats" with your words. (Add a letter each line.)

*These cannot be counted as homework but they are good way to practice if you want!*

- ◇ *Trace the words in shaving cream.*
- ◇ *Trace the words in sand.*
- ◇ *Make the words out of string or yarn.*
- ◇ *Write the words with sidewalk chalk.*
- ◇ *Write the words in the air with your finger.*
- ◇ *Sing the letters of the words.*
- ◇ *Write the words with glitter glue.*
